

Brexit 2019

As negotiations continue with some uncertainty for our long-term relationship with the EU we are, as are many businesses, preparing for 'Brexit' in April 2019.

The impact of Brexit, deal or no deal, needs to be considered for our own business operations as well as those of our customers and suppliers and also for our employees.

As we don't directly Import, the key to NBM maintaining our service levels through this period leading up to Brexit and into April, is to continually monitor our supply chain in their preparations for March 29th. This is something we are doing at regular intervals and will continue to do well after the Brexit deadline.

NBM will also be evaluating our own stock levels in the build up to April 2019 and will make adjustments where necessary to ensure we maintain our high standards of customer service.

Any potential impact to lead times or costs will be derived from our suppliers who may import materials. We will not know exactly how or who, if any, of our suppliers will be affected until the outcome of Brexit is confirmed. Any changes to costs or lead times will be communicated to our customers in the same way as they have been in the past. This will not affect the validity of any active quotes or project supports.

Any level of exporting that NBM get involved with is quoted on an individual basis and on current prices and global situations and therefore will adapt to whichever way the UK leaves the EU.
